4. Empowering Action and Allyship.

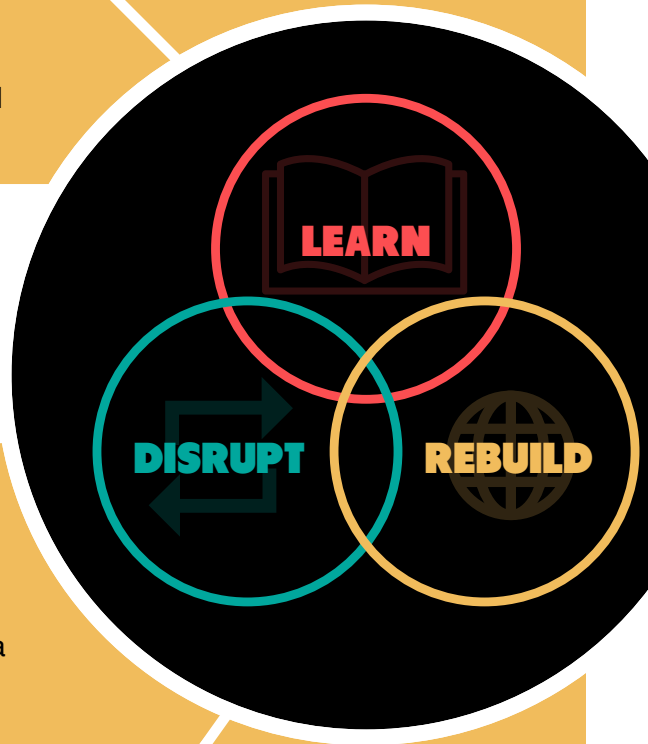
Our goal
